Inspired in Albuquerque NM and in Budapest, Hungary Patti Fox paints a new series for Art Walk 2007

In celebration of my first one woman show in Albuquerque, New Mexico and inspired by a morning walk with Roy Sumner Johnson, and dogs Maggie and Sophie, the body of work for Art Walk 2007 will be entitled "The Opening: Cactus and Wildflower".

The opening is a metaphor for the absolute support and love I felt in hanging my show, my adventure with my husband Dale, the opening night and the experiences at the balloon festival with a spectacular group of new friends.

I will be exploring the opening of one's soul in relationship to self and others. The support I receive from those around me is what allows me to live a creative life. I will be using nature, color, cactus and wildflowers to encourage me along the way.

While creating this new show I was notified that I was accepted into an international residency program in Budapest, Hungary for two weeks from December 27-January 9th. I will be creating a new body of work in Budapest that I will be bringing to Art Walk- April 28 and 29, 2007, entitled "The Opening: 88 Tiles of Budapest". I will be giving a public lecture to this international group of artists of my work, working side by side with the artists and touring this beautiful city. I will be donating a piece of my work to the Hungarian Multicultural Center and it will be exhibited at Vzivarosi Gallery in Budapest.

The Hungarian Multicultural Center provides artists with opportunities to experiment and explore new directions in their work. Resident artists are able to exchange ideas and experiences through presentations and informal discussions. The time and studio environment allows for intense periods of creativity free from the distractions of everyday pressures. Artists may use the residency to accomplish a specific project or to work in a creative and supportive atmosphere alongside other international artists.
