

Canyon Crest's Digital/Fine Arts Envision Conservatory finishes mural project for ArtWalk

Each spring, ArtWalk draws more than 100,000 visitors to Little Italy to take part in San Diego's largest urban arts festival. This year Canyon Crest Academy's Digital & Fine Arts Conservatory students will participate in ArtWalk as part of the Art Miles Mural Project. This collaborative international project will unite artists from across the globe via mural making. The program's goal is to complete 12 themes in 12 miles of murals. Art Miles Murals seeks to promote peace by bringing people from around the world together to work on a barrier breaking project that speaks in all languages. Canyon Crest students recently completed work for ArtWalk's "Fairy Tale"- themed Mile of Murals.

Production began in mid-February under the artistic direction of CCA artist-in-residence, Patti Fox. "I believe that bringing my art students into collaborative experiences in the bigger world helps them grow as artists and global citizens," Fox says.

Fox, a highly-regarded artist known for her brightly-colored, emotionally-charged paintings, is the co-creator of CCA's Visual Arts Program. She has been involved in ArtWalk since 1998.

Canyon Crest's Fairy Tale Murals will be displayed April 28 and 29, during ArtWalk, at KidsWalk in Amici Park on Date Street, three blocks East of India Street.

In 2010, after traveling the world on display, an exhibition of all the mural panels will be wrapped around the Great Pyramids of Egypt. To date, 41,000 people from 100 countries have already completed more than 14,000 murals. Art Miles Murals have been displayed at the Museum of Natural History in New York City and in cities in Mexico, Spain, Austria, Lebanon, Egypt and in Hong Kong.

The Canyon Crest Envision Conservatory and the Artist-In-Residence program are both made possible by funding from the Canyon Crest Academy Foundation.
